5.	Places wheelchair at the head of the bed, facing the foot of the bed, or at the foot of bed, facing the head of bed. Places wheelchair on resident's stronger side.				
6.	Removes wheelchair footrests close to the bed.				
7.	Locks wheelchair wheels.				
8.	Raises head of bed. Adjusts bed level to lowest position. Locks bed wheels.				
9.	Assists resident to a sitting position with feet flat on the floor.				
10.	Puts nonskid footwear on resident and fastens.				
11.	Stands in front of resident. Stands with feet about shoulder-width apart. Bends knees. Keeps back straight.

2.	Adjusts bed level to a low position, with height of bed equal to or slightly lower than the chair. Locks bed wheels.	
3.	Performs steps 11 through 14 above.	
4.	Helps resident pivot to bed with back of resident's legs against bed. When resident feels the bed, he slowly sits down on the side of the bed.	
5.	Removes transfer belt. Removes footwear. Makes resident comfortable.	
6.	Returns bed to lowest position. Removes privacy measures.	

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7.	Leaves call light within resident's reach.	
8.	Washes hands.	
9.	Is courteous and respectful at all times.	
10.	Reports any changes in resident to the nurse. Documents procedure using facility guidelines.
